At the Faculty of Medicine in Cluj-Napoca, studies end with the licensing exam.

It consists of a written test, a practical test and a final examination.

The written exam consists of a 120-question grid test over 3 hours, based on a topic announced 6 months before the exam.


The practical test is specific to our faculty and consists of presenting a clinical case for 20 minutes in front of the committee.

The thesis presentation is done in front of the committee for the thesis presentation, by groups of related specialties in 8-10 minutes, during which time the graduates present synthetically the results obtained in the research work they have done under the guidance of a tutor.


Each paper must also be submitted on CD and accompanied by:

- Evaluation sheet signed by the scientific tutor
- A sworn statement by the graduate on the originality of the work

The presentation of an ORIGINAL (MEDICAL RELATED) RESEARCH



The purpose of the thesis

To prove to anyone that the author of the thesis:

- was able to carry out an original scientific research under supervision
- present its results

Type of research

- Primary research
- ~~Systematic Reviews + MetaAnalysis~~

When you're doing your thesis

- **Direct contact with medical research:**
 - For most, it is the only possibility they have to see how medical truths are "born"
 - For some it is a possibility to join a research team
- **The possibility for everyone to demonstrate their creative ability (first of all for themselves but also for others)**
- **For the faculty it is a possibility to select the future doctoral students (assistants)**

How it starts?

- **Topic + Supervisor = Title**
- **The title should be announced to Dean's Office**
- **Standardized form, must be signed by the student, supervisor and the supervisor's head of the discipline.**

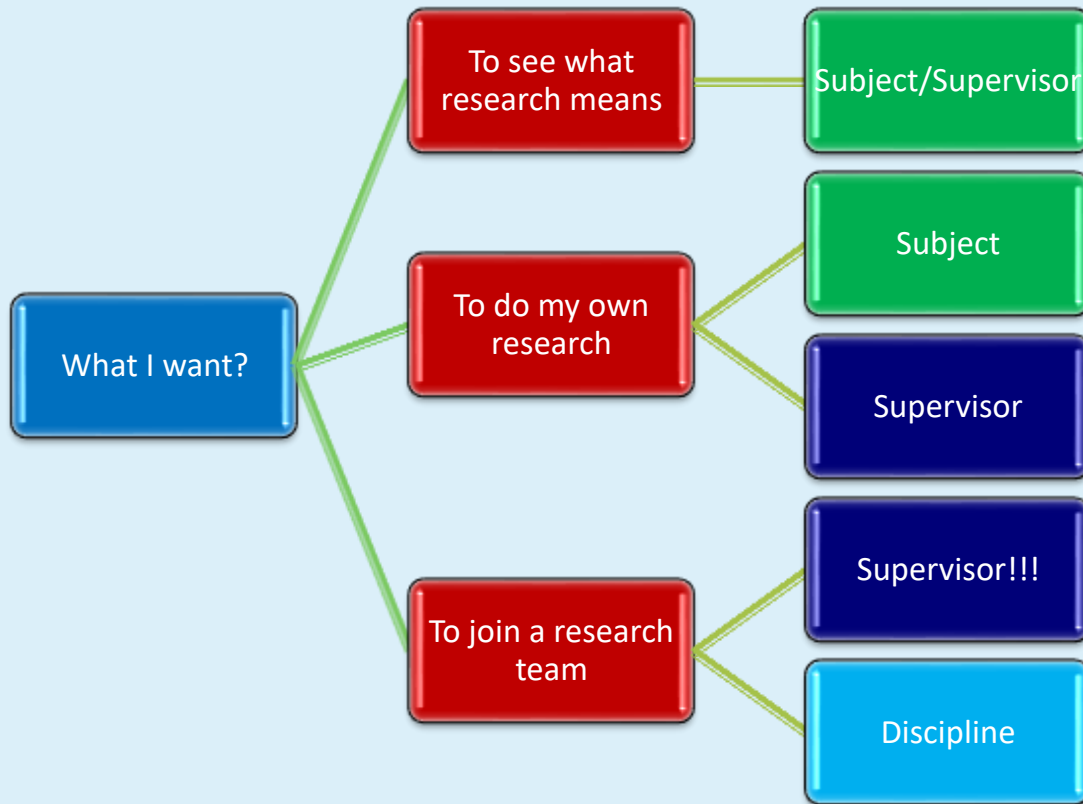
